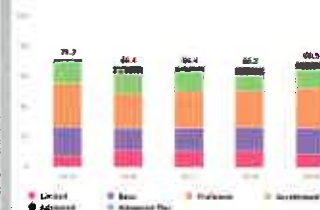

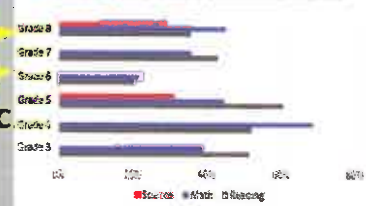

▶ 94% of our third graders passed the Third Grade Reading Guarantee!

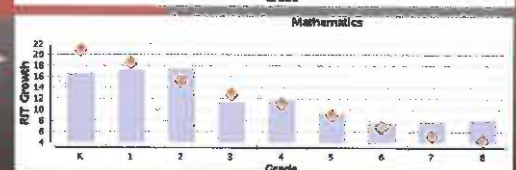
